



The parties to this Memorandum of Agreement (hereinafter referred to as the "MOA"), Connecticut State Colleges & Universities (hereinafter referred to as "CSCU"), the Federation of Technical College Teachers (hereafter "AFT"), the Congress of Connecticut Community Colleges ("the Congress"), and the AFSCME Administrators, Local 2480 ("AFSCME") agree as follows:

1. Whereas, due to the COVID-19 coronavirus global outbreak, additional time is needed to complete the Merit Awards process awarded by the President or Campus CEO,
2. The parties hereby agree to delay the deadline to submit merit award nominations to the President or Campus CEO to May 3, 2021.
3. The parties hereby agree to extend the selection process and notification to the recipients and the System Office due to expire on April 15th to May 7, 2021.
4. CSCU agrees that the deadline extension stated in #2 and #3 will be communicated to campus CEOs and the respective employees on a given campus.
5. This agreement is specific to the 2021 Merit Awards only and is not intended to modify any other terms or conditions of the contract as it applies to Merit Awards.


